Features

Installing Yadabyte Dictionary

Yadabyte Dictionary comes with two dictionaries:

The Big Dictionary: This one is the full dictionary; it contains nearly 150,000 definitions and is 5.5MB.

The Small Dictionary: This is a cut down version of the big dictionary; it contains nearly 60,000 definitions and is 2.5MB. The Small Dictionary is still a very comprehensive and useful dictionary.

Before installing Yadabyte Dictionary you need to decide which dictionary to install. The data file for each dictionary is found in the download archive in the corresponding folder. This file is called "YBDictData.pdb".

Installing to Internal Memory

1. Locate YadabyteDictionary.prc and YBDictData.pdb on your PC.
2. Double click each file, and select the hotsync® username for the Palm device on which you wish to install the software.
3. Once both files are in the queue to be installed, click the "Done" button
4. Hotsync® your handheld, and the software will be installed.

Installing to a Memory Card

1. Locate YadabyteDictionary.prc and YBDictionaryData.pdb
2. Double click each file, and select the hotsync® username for the Palm device on which you wish to install the software
3. The files are now queued to be installed to the internal memory of your handheld. To change this to the card, click on the "Change Destination" button
4. In the "Change Destination" window, click on each of the files Yadabyte Dictionary files you want to move to the card, and click the button labelled ">>"
5. Click "OK" to return to the main screen of the install tool, the Yadabyte Dictionary files should now be listed along with their installation destination
6. Once both files are in the queue, and the destination for them to be installed is correct, click the "Done" button
7. Hotsync® your handheld

Registering Yadabyte Dictionary

In order to register your copy of Yadabyte Dictionary once you have purchased it follow these instructions:

1. Launch (run) the application by clicking on the icon.

2. Press "Menu" button on silk screen. (The button at bottom Left corner in the Graffiti area.)
3. Select "About Yadabyte Dictionary " from "Options" menu.
4. Press "Register" button in the "About Yadabyte Dictionary "screen.
5. Enter the unlock code in space provided and press "Enter".

Using Yadabyte Dictionary

Yadabyte Dictionary has been designed to be pure simplicity to use. The interface is divided onto two elements, the word list and the definition tabs.

The Word List

The word list is where you find the words you want to view. To find a word simply write it in the search box at the bottom of the screen. As you write each letter the word will be built up. When you see the word you are interested in, just tap on it in the list and you will be taken to the definitions for that word.

The Definitions Tabs

Yadabyte Dictionary's interface breaks the definitions of words up into their word forms, such as verb, noun, adverb and adjective. This makes it much easier for you get to the definition you are looking for.

So, for example, if you look at the definition of "*fast*" you will see four tabs for the four word forms. Tapping on, say, the verb tab will take you to all the definitions of "*fast*" as a verb.

The Definitions Display

The actual text of the definitions has been formatted to convey the lexicographic information to you as simply as possible.

The numbered bold text displays the actual definition of the word. One word may have many definitions, these are displayed in order.

Following the definition there will often be synonyms (blue on coloured devices). This feature makes Yadabyte Dictionary useful as a thesaurus.

The bulleted items (green on coloured devices) are useful examples for the defined words. These are intended to further clarify the sense of the defined word.
