Installation

Before installing PocketLingo 2.0, please make sure that your Pocket PC device meets the System Requirements mentioned above.

Installing PocketLingo Using a Windows Computer

1. Download the PocketLingo zip file (*see Appendix A for a list of zip filenames*) if necessary from <http://www.pocketlingo.com/products/> on to your computer and extract the contents of the .zip file.
2. Connect your Pocket PC device to your computer.
3. Open the folder created by extracting the contents of the .zip file from Step 1.
4. Double-click the PocketLingo_Setup.exe file to install the PocketLingo application to your PDA
5. Follow the instructions in the wizard and on your Pocket PC to complete the installation.
6. Double-click the dictionary Setup file to install the dictionary files to your PDA. See Appendix B for a list of product setup filenames.
7. Follow the instructions in the wizard and on your Pocket PC to complete the installation.

Installing PocketLingo onto an External Memory Card

HLCSOFT recommends that you use the default Setup.exe installer to install all files to their default locations on your device if the space is available. Otherwise, follow the directions below to install the program onto an External Memory Card.

1. Download the PocketLingo zip file (*see Appendix A for a list of zip filenames*) if necessary from <http://www.pocketlingo.com/products/> on to your computer and extract the contents of the .zip file.
2. Make sure to have your memory card inserted in the device and connect your Pocket PC device to your computer.
3. Open the folder created by extracting the contents of the .zip file from Step 1.
4. Double-click the PocketLingo_Setup.exe file to install the PocketLingo application to your PDA.
5. Follow the instructions in the wizard and on your Pocket PC to complete the installation. From the drop-down selection in the window that should appear, choose "Storage Card" instead of "Main Memory".
6. Double-click the dictionary Setup file to install the dictionary files. From the drop-down selection in the window that should appear, choose "Storage Card" instead of "Main Memory".
7. Follow the instructions in the wizard and on your Pocket PC to complete the installation.

Uninstalling PocketLingo

1. From your Pocket PC device, tap the Start menu, and then tap Settings.
2. Tap the "System" tab to open the system property sheet, and tap the Memory icon.
3. Tap the Running Programs tab, and if PocketLingo appears in the list, tap to select it, and tap the Stop button.
4. Tap the OK button in the top-right corner of the screen to close the Memory window.
5. Tap the Remove Programs icon also in the System settings page.
6. Tap the title you wish to remove from the list and then tap Remove. See Appendix A for a list of PocketLingo product titles that appear on the Remove Programs list.
7. You may want to use FileExplorer or another file browser to ensure all related files were deleted from the system:
 - a. If you installed the program to your device, navigate to \My Device\Program Files\HLCSoft\PocketLingo, delete the sub-folder named after the title you have removed and all of its contents.
 - b. If you installed the program to your memory card, navigate to \My Device and open your memory card folder, delete the product folder and all of its contents. The folder uses the same name as is displayed in the Remove Programs list. Appendix B contains a list of these names for each product.

The Registration Code - What, Where, and How








The Registration Code is a combination of letters and numbers. The registration code consists of the numbers 0-9 and letters A-F only (for example: 1D35FC67A1). To enter your Registration Code:

1. Start PocketLingo.
2. Go to **Menu > Help > Registration**.
3. Type your Registration Code into the PocketLingo registration screen.
4. Tap **Register** to continue or **Not Yet** to quit the registration process. If you quit, you may return later to register the product. The full dictionary will only be available after you have entered the correct Registration Code and completed the registration process by tapping **Register** on the registration screen.

Using PocketLingo

Overview


PocketLingo's main view contains the following objects:

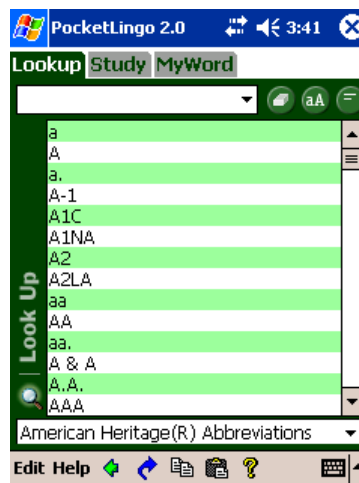
	<i>Back graphic</i> button Allows you to flip between the current and last viewed screen.
	<i>Help</i> button Displays tips on using PocketLingo.
	<i>Search query field</i> Enter the word you would like to look up.
	<i>Select and Go ("Jump")</i> Select the word within the definition to go directly to the definition of the selected word.
	<i>Eraser</i> button Deletes the entry in the Search query field.
	<i>Font size</i> button Choose between large or regular fonts.
	<i>View select</i> button Choose between the normal and full index views of the word list.

The **Pronunciation Key**, **Tips**, **Abbreviation**, **Registration**, and **About PocketLingo** screens can be found by tapping the **Help** menu item and selecting the option of interest.

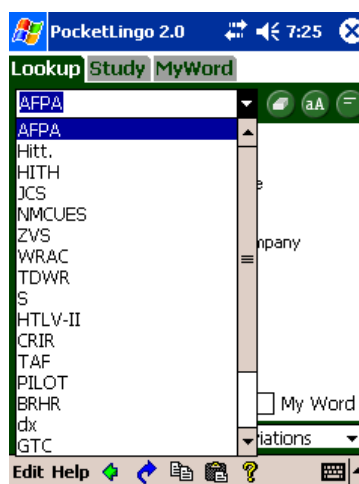
Lookup Tab

1. To search for a word, type it into the Search query field and a list of possible matches will be displayed below.
2. Tap the word you want on the list.
Tip: You can also enter your query using the standard keyboard of your handheld device.

If you have a word in your clipboard, you can paste it into the query field by tapping on the  button.



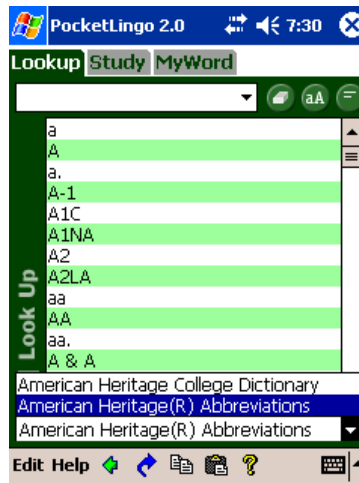
If you are looking up a word you have looked up recently, click on the arrow next to the search query field. PocketLingo will show up to 20 recently looked up words in each dictionary.



If you want to start another search, tap the eraser button, which will erase the current

contents of the search query field. Alternately, you can use the backspace key on the keyboard to erase one character at a time.

To switch between different dictionaries, tap the title of the dictionary located at the bottom of the lookup screen. A pop-up list containing all your PocketLingo 2.0 dictionaries will appear. Just select one to go to that dictionary. Please keep in mind that only version 2.0 dictionaries will appear on this list.




Definition

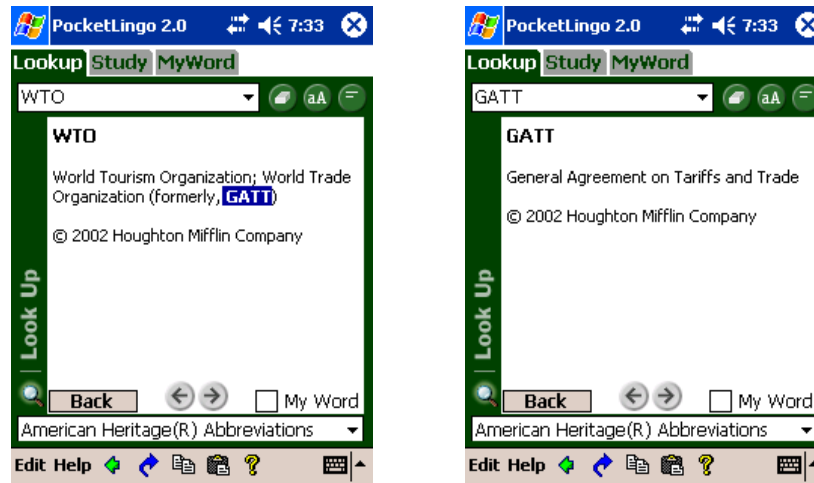
The definition will be displayed after tapping the word in the **LookUp** screen. Use the scroll buttons to view the entire definition.



If you would like to add the word to the MyWord list, check on the MyWord box, as shown here: ☒ My Word. The **Back** button will return you to the term list.

A new feature in PocketLingo, select any word in the definition of the current word and




tap on  (Jump) to instantly search for that selected word.

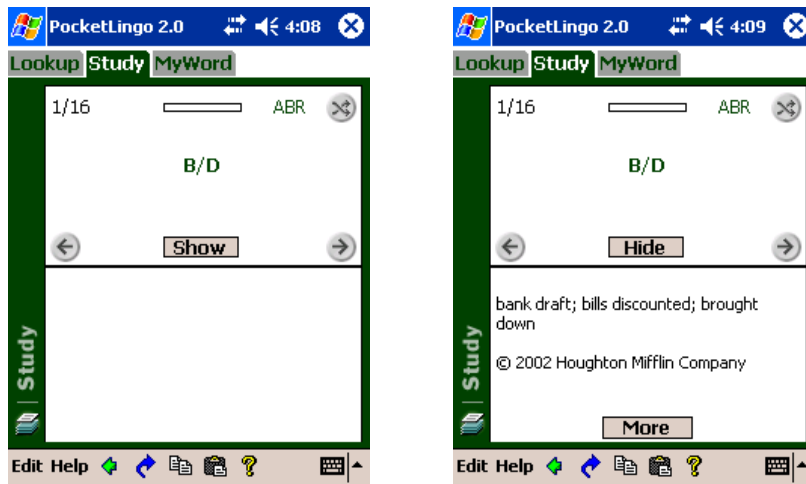


If the word is in the dictionary, the definition for that word will display. If the word tapped does not exactly match any term, the closest match will be displayed at the top of the term list.

Study Tab








The Study function is designed to help you build a more powerful vocabulary. It is similar to but much more powerful than a written study card.

1. Tap on the **Show** / **Hide** button to show or hide the definition of the word.
2. Tap on the **More** button to bring up a complete definition of the word.
3. Use the  button to review the previous word, the  button to review the next word on the list, or the  button to review a random word from the MyWord list.



The Goal Bar  shows how long the word has been on the list.

Study Control

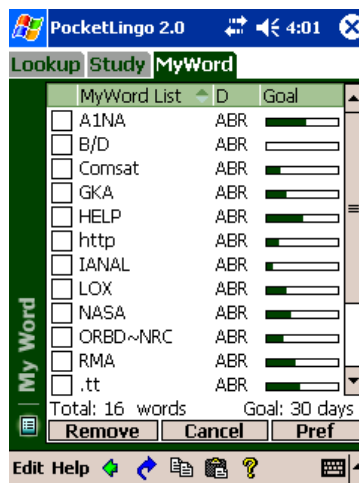
	<i>Previous</i> button Moves to previous word on the list.
	<i>Next</i> button Moves to next word on the list.
	<i>Shuffle</i> button Shuffles the words on the list.
	<i>Goal</i> Bar Indicates how close you are to your goal.
	<i>Show</i> button Shows the definition of the word.
	<i>Hide</i> button Hides the definition of the word.
	<i>More</i> button Brings up a complete definition of the word.

MyWord Tab

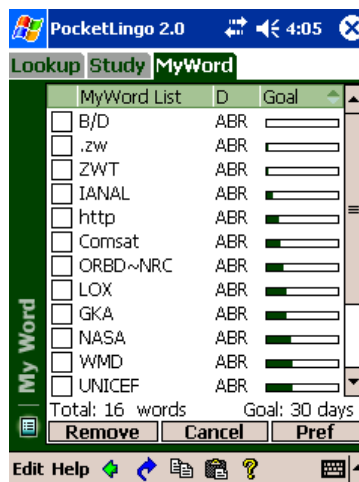
MyWord displays the complete list of words that you have selected to save. This allows you to see in a quick glance all the words you plan to study. You can save up to 1000 words in this list.

To see the definition of a particular word, just tap on the word in the list. You may use the scroll bar to view the entire list.

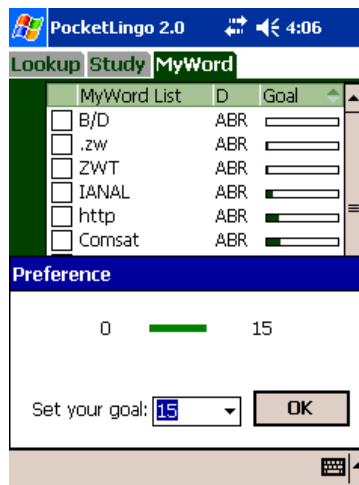
To sort the list in alphabetical (ascending or descending) order, tap on **MyWord List** ▲.



To sort the list by how long the words have been on the list, tap on **Goal** ▲.



The **Pref** button allows you to set a goal for how quickly you want to learn the words on your list. The darkened portion of the Goal Bar indicates how long the word has been on the list and allows you to see how close you are to your goal.



To remove a word from the list, first tap the check box next to the word, and then tap the **Remove** button.

Preface to the German-English Dictionary

This electronic edition of **Langenscheidt's German Dictionary** comprises a total of around 120,000 headwords and phrases. Comprehensive and authoritative, Langenscheidt's German Dictionary focuses on modern usage and covers everyday language as well as vocabulary from many specialist fields.

Using the Dictionary

1. English Headwords

- a) The alphabetical order of the headwords has been carefully observed throughout. This also applies to irregular forms, where additional cross-references to the basic forms are given.
- b) Centered dots within a headword indicate syllabification:

cul·ti·vate ... , cul·ti·va·tion

2. Pronunciation

- a) The pronunciation of English headwords is given in square brackets by means of the symbols of the International Phonetic Association (IPA).
- b) Derived headwords having one of the suffixes which are part of the list of common prefixes and suffixes are normally given without transcription.

3. Arrangement of the entries

Entries are generally divided up by means of

- a) Roman numerals to distinguish parts of speech (noun, adjective, adverb; transitive, intransitive or reflexive verb, etc)
- b) Arabic numerals (running consecutively within the article and independent of Roman numerals) to differentiate between meanings
- c) small letters for further differentiation of meaning.

4. Subject Labels

The field of knowledge from which a headword or some of its meanings are taken is indicated by abbreviated labels or other labels written out in full. A label placed immediately after the headword refers to all translations. A label preceding an individual translation refers to this only.

5. Usage Labels

The indication of the level of usage by abbreviations such as *ugs.*, *sl.* etc refers to the headword. Wherever possible the same level of usage between headword and translation has been aimed at.

6. Translation

- a) Many translations are supported by additional explanations, glosses, etc, which are printed in italics; for intransitive verbs a subject may be indicated, for transitive verbs an object, for adjectives a collocation, etc:

put (...) *Hand etc, fig Geld, Zeit stecken* (**in[to]** in *Akk*) (...) *jemanden in eine unangenehme Lage etc, etwas auf den Markt, in Ordnung etc bringen* (...) *etwas in Kraft, in Umlauf etc*

setzen (...) *Geld* setzen (**on** auf *Akk*) (...) *Schuld* geben (**on** *Dat*)

- b) Where a German preposition may govern the dative or the accusative case, the case is given in brackets:

dis•claim ... *JUR* verzichten *od* keinen Anspruch erheben auf (*Akk*), *Erbschaft* ausschlagen

7. Illustrative Phrases

and their translations follow the translation of the headword:

gab ... *have the gift of the gab* ein flottes Mundwerk haben

Dach ... *ugs fig eins aufs Dach kriegen* get it in the neck

Troubleshooting

Q: How do I check available space on my Pocket PC?

To check the space you have on your Pocket PC device, please do the following:

1. Tap Start->Settings on your device.
2. Tap the "System" tab at the bottom.
3. Then tap on "Memory". You will see the Free Memory space.

Please note that you will need about 556 KB of space to install PocketLingo Abbreviations.

Q: I get an error that says "Dictionary Not Found".

This error occurs when PocketLingo cannot locate a dictionary file and usually means the installation did not complete properly. Please re-install the program, and if you continue to have trouble please contact us by using our support form at:
